

## Information about our transport processes (in particular dangerous goods)

### General information

Usually our sales contracts are based on INCOTERMS 2000. These international trade terms which are issued and recommended from the International Chamber of Commerce in Paris ([www.iccwbo.org](http://www.iccwbo.org)) regulate:

- the rights and obligations of seller and buyer
- who bears costs and risks of consignments of goods.

Primarily we dispatch our products:

EXW Berlin

CIP .....(named place/airport) / CIF.....(named place/port)

DDU.....(named place)

The choice of clause depends on:

- mode of transport (by road, by sea or by air)
- nature of goods (hazardous or not restricted)
- forwarder/transporter
- customer requirements

### Dangerous goods via air transport

For small dangerous goods consignments, reasonable door-to-door-services from FedEx for a lot of destinations are possible (DDU.....named place).

Unfortunately, this service is for dangerous goods, for example, not available to:

Finland, Greece, Russia, Lithuania, China, Mexico and Australia. This concerns further countries, for others there are restrictions.

For shipments with higher weights or in cases of non-availability of FedEx services, we instruct our forwarder to book cargo space. Then we deliver CIP....named airport and the consignee is responsible for picking up the goods from the airport. We provide all necessary flight details in time. Sometimes it is possible for us to organise also the transport from the airport to the receiver (DDU....named place). However, in general this is very expensive.

### Surcharges for additional documentation

We charge for 1 document 20 Euros, for 2 documents 30 Euros for issuing the following necessary papers:

- Shipper's Declaration (dangerous goods by air transport)
- IMO Dangerous Goods Declaration (transport by ship or ferry)
- Export Declaration (shipments to Non-EU-Countries with a value more than 1000 Euros)
- A.T.R. Certificate (only used when trading goods with Turkey)

If the value of goods > 3000 Euros for shipments to Non-EU-Countries, you have to add costs (approx. 30 Euros) for duty advance notification.

**Each customer may purchase EXW Berlin. In this case please give us all contact details of your forwarder/transporter. Please note usually DHL Express and UPS don't accept dangerous goods for transportation. Please check whether your agreement contains a clause referring to these special conditions.**
